



Recreation Updated Covid-19 Guidelines and Policies
June 1, 2022

Code of Conduct for Staff, Clients, Visitors and Volunteers:

- All staff will follow the Northeast Arc Recreation Call-Out procedure and Code of Conduct
- Staff must check each participant for symptoms, including temperature checks, at the start of all indoor, outdoor and community-based recreation programming
- All Recreation Staff reserve the right to ask a client to leave programming if concern of symptoms or temperatures arise
- Volunteers must follow Covid-19 guidelines including symptom and temperature check

Covid-19 Positive Procedures for Recreation Programming *regardless of vaccination status:*

- Remain out of programming for 5 days from the onset of testing positive
- If you have no symptoms after 5 days, you may return to programming
- A mask must be worn for an additional 5 days after the quarantine has ended at all programming
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until fever resolves for 24-hours

Mask Guidance for Staff, Clients, Visitors and Volunteers *regardless of vaccination status:*

- **Indoors Programming at a Northeast Arc Facility:**
 - Masks required
- **Community Facilities where Recreation Programs are running:**
 - Follow the Community Facility's mask requirement
- **Outdoor Programming at a Northeast Arc Facility:**
 - Not required to wear masks for outside activities when 3 feet social distancing can be maintained
 - If 3 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained; mask wearing will be requested

Sanitization:

- Sanitation of hands, equipment, materials and tables will continue to be sanitized before, during, and after all Recreation Programming.

Food during Recreation Programming:

- Snacks will be provided to participants during Friday Night Happenings in individualized bags when possible.
- Sharing of food, drinks and personal property is prohibited for all staff, participants and volunteers.
